

General terms and conditions

Walks with the St. Bernards

Participation in the walks calls for:

- A good level of fitness.
- Footwear designed for walking on rough terrain.
- All-weather clothing.

If the above requirements and the safety instructions issued on the day are not complied with, participation in the walk may be denied. A decision taken by the group leader to exclude a participant from the walk is final and no refund will be made.

- ✓ Participants' own dogs and pushchairs may not be taken on the walk.
- ✓ Participants authorise the Barry Foundation to publish photos and videos in which they appear.

Cancellations

Cancellation of a reservation for an activity must be communicated in writing by the customer (email to event@fondation-barry.ch) as soon as possible. Cancellation of a reservation that is not the responsibility of the Barry Foundation incurs a cancellation fee:

- Seven or more days before the start of the activity → no fee, refund in the form of vouchers
- Fewer than seven days before the start of the activity → 100% of the cost of the activity

The walks take place in all weathers. However, the Barry Foundation reserves the right to cancel a walk if the conditions are considered dangerous. In this event, the Barry Foundation will refund the cost in its entirety. Cancellations are communicated to the participants by email to the address given when reserving.

Latecomers

Late arrival of up to 5 minutes is permissible. After that, the group will start the activity without the latecomers. No refund is provided in the event of lateness or no-show.

Other provisions

Insurance: insurance covering participation in the activity is up to the participants, who are responsible for themselves. Health and accident insurance that includes rescue costs is the responsibility of the participants. Children must be under the direct supervision of legal quardian.

COVID-19 pandemic: measures/restrictions related to COVID-19 must be observed (protective face coverings, hand disinfection, etc.).

Applicable law: subject to Swiss law

Jurisdiction: the place of jurisdiction is Martigny
